I am pleased to introduce you to AboutFace: Canada's facial difference charity. Our mission is to cultivate equity and opportunity for individuals with a facial difference through supportive programming, advocacy, and education.

For almost 40 years, AboutFace has been working for and with the facial difference community. More than two million people in Canada are living with a facial difference. A person with a facial difference refers to anyone whose appearance, from the neck or above, has been affected by a congenital (from birth), acquired (after birth), or episodic (comes and goes) condition or syndrome.

In November of this year, we will hold an online auction to raise money to support our work. In 2022, AboutFace supported more than 2,000 people across Canada, and we reached millions through our advocacy and education work.

Locally, across British Columbia in large and small communities, we provide psychosocial support, resources, and community events.
