Pacific Coastal Airlines does not accept Dangerous Goods as cargo on any of our wheeled aircrafts out of any of our Airports. This includes Lithium Ion Batteries, loose or installed in devices.


Our subsidiary company Wilderness Seaplanes will accept Dangerous Goods that falls within the definition of "*Limited Access*". This would generally occur out of their Port Hardy and Bella Bella operations.

Limited Access – *Dangerous Goods that are transported to or from a location where access is limited and there is no other practical or readily available means of transport (TDGR 12.9)*
